"In an era dominated by advances in assisted reproductive technologies such as In Vitro Fertilization (IVF) and Preimplantation Genetic Testing for Aneuploidies (PGT-A), the necessity and scope of reproductive surgery is increasingly questioned. Historically, reproductive surgery was central to fertility treatment, addressing anatomical obstacles that impeded conception. Today, with the ability to bypass many physical barriers through IVF and screen embryos for genetic anomalies via PGT-A, clinicians and patients alike are reconsidering surgical interventions.
